Frequently Asked Questions

Is this the Saline show I heard about?

Probably. The show has a large following and is the top rated show by Michigan Crafter Magazine. Due to this, we do attract quite a crowd. If you want to avoid the crowds, come later in the day. The crafters who have booths at this show know to bring extra inventory, so don't worry about not getting what you came to buy. Visit us on the web at www.salineshow.com for more information.

What are the hours of the show this year?

The show will open at 8:00am and close at 3:30pm. If you come early expect a line. Since most lines are outside it's a good idea to dress warm. Restrooms are available inside with a paid admission, so plan accordingly.

I don't have all day to shop - what should I do?

The show is very popular, so expect some crowds. The best time to easily get around the show quickly is by coming in the afternoon.

How much does it cost to get in?

The admission fee is \$3 per person. Children under 10 are free. The proceeds from admission benefit a variety of Saline Area School youth programs.

What's the 1:00-3:30pm door prize?

This year we have a goodie bag door prize for those who pays admission between 1:00pm and 3:30pm(While supplies last). So come in the afternoon, avoid the crowds and get crafter products and redeemable coupons worth atleast \$5!

Where should we park?

*Due to the large number of dedicated shoppers, the high school and middle school parking areas fill up quick. We offer a free shuttle between buildings.. There is also a free shuttle stop at the Visteon Plant on Michigan Ave (on the East side of town). This is a great way to get to the show, **you'll be dropped off right at the door.** You will then be picked up at the same door and returned right to your car.*

Can I page someone if we get separated?

Unfortunately, no. The intercom system at the school isn't loud enough to be heard effectively when the show is busy. We instruct staff to direct any lost or separated groups to gather in the ATM machine area.

I want to know if the crafter _____ is at the show?

You'll get a program when you arrive at the show, or pick one up around town in the weeks prior. The program has a nice booth map and an alphabetical list of the crafters at the show, along with their booth number. Check out www.salineshow.com for more detailed crafter and booth information.

I'm out of cash, but I want to keep spending?

Great! Check with the individual crafters to see if they accept checks and/or credit cards, many do both. We also have an ATM (cash machine) on site. The machine is located near booth 35 for your convenience.

How do I know if I've won a raffle prize?

The raffle area is located near the cafeteria. The raffle winners are posted on the wall, so check it often. The drawings times are posted in the raffle area and you do not need to be present to win. If you win, we'll call you.

Where can I eat and rest?

We have a great concession area at the show. The food is great. You can take a rest and gear up to keep shopping. There is no food or drink allowed outside the eating area, this is a school policy, please help us follow it.

I would like to have a booth next year?

There are interested crafter sign up sheets located at the admission doors. Fill out the form and you will get an application for next years' show.

Can I get on the mailing list so I get reminders about the show?

Sure, sign up near the admission doors and we'll keep you informed of upcoming events.

Why can't I bring my stroller in?

We don't allow strollers for the safety of everyone. Many booths have sharp or heavy items right at the level of most strollers, we don't want to see any child harmed.

Is the show handicap accessible?

Yes, the show and building are handicap accessible. There is extra designated handicap parking on the North side of the school. Parking lot workers will direct appropriately when they see the hanging tag.
